- Abstract must be no longer than 500 words. Electronic submission in MS Word document format is required. Formatting guidelines:
 - 11 point Arial font
 - 1.5 spacing
 - Paper size: letter (8.5" x 11")
 - Adhere to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements of Chicago citation style
- Submit via email ncpagat60@yahoo.com on or before **30 November 2011 (Wednesday, 5:00PM)**.
- Abstract must include the following:
 - Title of the paper
 - Author's name, affiliation, designation, and city/country
 - Email address and other contact details
- The submission has not been previously published/presented at another conference, nor is it before another conference for consideration
- All submitted abstracts will be subject to a review and the Program Committee will make a final selection of papers for the conference on the basis of this.
- Authors of accepted abstracts shall be notified on **31 January 2012 (Tuesday)**.
- Accepted abstracts will be included in the conference program.
- Full paper is due for submission on 30 April 2012.
